WHEREAS, the Village of Muir has developed the plan as a guideline for improving recreation and enhancing natural resource conservation for the Village of Muir, and

WHEREAS, after the public hearing, the Village of Muir voted to adopt said Recreation Plan 2018-2022 for the Village of Muir.
