## Ordinance Number 24

An ordinance relative to the obtaining of a permit for the construction, erection, conversion, or alternation of buildings within the Village limits of the Village of Muir, Ionia County, Michigan, to be known as ordinance number 24.

## THE VILLAGE OF MUIR ORDAINS:

Section I That no person, firm, or corporation shall hereafter construct, erect, convert, or alter move, or place upon any lot or land insaid village a building or buildings or structure of any kind, name, or nature, without first having submitted to the village council of said village a written application for permission to build with plans or specifications of such proposed building or structure showing where the same is to located, its position upon the street, distance therefore, kind of material to be used and purpose for which to be used, and name of builder.

Section II Such application shall be submitted to the clerk of said village, for presentation to the village council, with a fee of one (\$1.00) dollar to go to the general fund of said village.

Section III The village council shall have and does have the power to prescribe conditions, locations, and qualifications as to all buildings and structures hereafter to be built and constructed in said village, all in its reasonable discretion considering the health, safety, and welfare of the general public.

Section IV Upon receipt of such application the village council shall within 30 days consider same at a meeting thereof and by resolution of record grant or refuse by majority vote the permission requested in said application; and such determination shall be final. A duly certified copy of such resolution shall operate and be a permit or refusal as the case may be for such construction, in accord with the terms of the application.

Section V Any person or persons, and if a corporation then in such case the officers thereof, who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance by building or attempting to build, construct, erect, covert, alter or move or place any building or structure within said village of Muir without having obtained permission to do so by such resolution of said council as in this ordinance set forth and without complying with this ordinance shall on conviction for such violation be liable to a fine of not over one hundred (\$100.00) dollars, or imprisonment in the Ionia County, Michigan, County Jail for aperiod of not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court. Each day that violation be permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

Section VI Any justice of the peace of the township of Lyons, Ionia County, Michigan or any adjoining township, or city of an adjoining township, shall have power to hear and determine any and all complaints under this ordinance and to try any and all offenders for violation of any of its provisions.

Section VII This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the 25th day of May, 1958 at 12:000'clock noon, and shall be known as Ordinance # 24.
