## STATE OF MICHIGAN VILLAGE OF MUIR ORDINANCE NO.49

AN ORDINANCE TO FULFILL THE REQUIRMENTS OF 2004 PA 286-300 IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE TERM AND MANNER OF ELECTION OF GENERAL LAW VILLAGE TRUSTEES.

THE VILLAGE OF MUIR ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Terms and Elections of Trustees.</u> Three of the village trustees shall be elected at each biennial regular village election for a term of four years and until their successors are elected and qualified.

<u>Section 2.</u> Next Regular Election. The next regular election for the Village of Muir is September 11, 2007, that is, the first Tuesday after the second Monday of an odd year.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Extension of Terms.</u> The terms of the following incumbent trustees shall be extended as indicated:

- (a) Scott Davis, Douglas Hyland, and Todd Underwood, through September 11, 2007 and until their successors are elected and qualified.
- (b) Lance Walkington, Leo Waterman, and Adam Yuhas through September 15, 2009 and until their successors are elected and qualified.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption unless a petition signed by not less than ten (10) percent of the registered electors of the village filed with the Village Clerk within the forty-five (45) day period, in which case this ordinance shall take effect upon approval at an election upon the question as to whether this ordinance shall be approved.

The adoption of the foregoing ordinance was moved by, <u>Leo Waterman</u>, supported by <u>Todd Underwood</u>, and by roll call vote was approved by a vote of two-thirds of the members of the Council of the Village of Muir with the following council members voting in favor of the ordinance and the following council members voting against the adoption of the ordinance.
