NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR MICHIGAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING FOR THE SANITARY PUMP STATION AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

The Village of Muir will conduct a public hearing on May 10, 2022 at 7 PM at the Village Office, 122 W. Superior St. Muir, MI 48860, for the purpose of affording citizens an opportunity to examine and submit comments on the proposed application for a CDBG grant.

The Village of Muir proposes to request \$1,407,840.00 in CDBG funds to abandon the Villages wastewater pump station, and replace it with a new pump station, the project will also replace 2800' of wastewater force main from the wastewater pump station to the Village's Wastewater Treatment Facility, effluent pipe replacement at the Wastewater Treatment Facility, and a generator at the Village's water tower. The Village of Muir will contribute \$268,160.00 from local funding. The project will benefit all residents within the Village and benefit at least 51% low to moderate income persons. No persons will be displaced as a result of the proposed activities.
